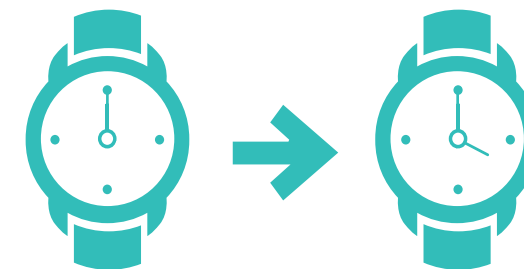
VULNERABLE ROAD USER DEATHS DECREASED FROM **67** TO **65**.
